HIGHLIGHTS:

Introduced 72 high school students to possible manufacturing careers in the inaugural Student Manufacturing Career Day.

Launched a new Chamber Association Health Plan in partnership with Health Alliance, helping eligible members save 17 to 25 percent on health insurance.

Counseled **25 entrepreneurs** in various stages of business development.

More than 400 community members volunteered in the iRead · iCount program. Urbana District 116 reported 85 percent of participating students experienced growth in letter identification and reading with **Champaign** Unit 4 reporting 92 percent of participating students reaching similar achievements.

Led Champaign County First efforts, resulting in one million federal dollars allocated to study our sole source of drinking water, the Mahomet Aguifer, and a future \$110 million investment in I-57 rail corridor improvements.

Spearheaded a coalition of 50+ Illinois Chambers in advocating for the state to prevent rising business costs by paying off the Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund.
